As an Irish American and member of the Ancient Order of Hibernians I am very concerned that the repartitioning of Ireland would have seriously undermine the cause of peace in Ireland, a peace which the United States played a major role. The people of Northern Ireland overwhelming rejected Brexit, but due to the lack of progress in ratifying an agreement are now facing the prospect of disproportionately bearing the consequences of Brexit. A hard border in Ireland threatens the bridges of trust and cooperation that have been built in the twenty years since the signing of the Good Friday agreement. The peace, prosperity and security of Ireland should not be sacrificed for Brexit.
